SPRING SEMESTER (January Start Date) + Early Action: October 1 + Priority: November 1 + Regular Decision: December 1 + Regular Decision: April 1

FALL SEMESTER

(August Start Date) + Early Action: December 1 + Priority: February 15

Regular decision applications will be accepted on a spaceavailable basis. If admitted, you will be notified of the scholarship decision within two weeks.
